Leader's information

It's for all sections to take part, so everyone can join together to enjoy what will hopefully be a great day. We have sole use of Woodlands Adventure so we can enjoy the freedom of the site in full.

Rainbows can take part in a visit to the animal petting areas, pond dipping, nature collages, bouncy castles, puzzle solving/team challenge as well as the camp fire. As they cannot take part in the bigger on site activities, the difference in price reflects this

Brownies, Guides, Senior Section can take part in the following (consent form permitting and ability to swim 50 metres for the water activities), canoeing, archery, zip wire, assault course, puzzle solving/team challenge, geocaching, bouncy castles as well as the camp fire. Please note, Young Leaders wishing to take part in the activities will be charged the full amount of £40, otherwise they will need to pay the Leaders charges of £10

All girls (bar Rainbows) will need a change of clothes and towels as showers are needed after certain water activities. Full details will be given on the consent forms nearer the time

As a hot dog tea is being provided we will need to know all dietary requirements as requested on the consent forms.

Coaches will be organised from 3 pick-up points (TBC north, south and central Birmingham) as vehicular access is extremely limited on site so all participants will need to travel on the coaches provided.

Uniform will need to be worn by all – please ask that names are clearly labelled in all clothes

All activities will continue in the event of bad weather so good waterproof coats/outerwear will be needed.

Everyone will need to bring a packed lunch with a drinks bottle, but squash/water will be provided throughout the day with tea/coffee available for leaders

The girls will be placed into groups so the numbers as stated by Woodlands are met. We would hope that Guides and Senior Section will be able to take part in certain activities without leaders.

Once you have booked your places all consent forms will be sent to your nominated contact and will need to be completed and one copy will need to be kept by the unit for use on the day and one will need to be returned to the organising team for groups to be organised prior to the day itself
